Position Summary

Under the direction of, and in partnership with the Director of Finance, maintain the financial health of Safe Haven Shelter & Resource Center.

Essential Functions

Bookkeeping:

- Code invoices, post accounts payable, and prepare weekly check runs in a timely manner.
- Perform bi-weekly payroll. Deposit taxes and remit all deductions.
- Post cash receipts and make timely bank deposits.
- Retain all invoices, receipts and time sheets in an organized manner.
- Maintain fixed asset records and track and tag inventory.

Reporting:

- Assist in preparing for annual agency audit with independent auditing firm.
- Prepare all quarterly tax related reports.
- Prepare year end reports and documents to include W2s, 1099s, pension fund year end census, etc.

General Operations Support:

- Assist in the overall management of the organization as a member of Safe Haven's Leadership Team.
- Assist with hiring process, which includes coordinating job posts and interviews, performing reference checks, and completing all new hire paperwork.
- Assist with preparing documents for Board meetings, all staff meetings, and other meetings.
- Maintain organizational records.
- Attend meetings and trainings as required.
- Administer the pension plan.
- Keep records of benefit plan participation such as health and dental insurance, and other information such as records of vacation, sick time, holidays etc. for employees.
- Maintain office supply inventory and office equipment including copier, fax, etc.
- Perform all other work related duties as assigned.

Education, Experience and Skills Required

- High level of accounting experience in a nonprofit setting (including generally accepted accounting principles and procedures, accrual-basis accounting, and financial reporting).
- Thorough understanding of all accounting functional areas.
- Ability to use spreadsheets and accounting software.
- Advanced understanding of generally accepted accounting principles.
- Ability to organize and prioritize workload; ability to meet deadlines.
- Strong written, verbal and interpersonal skills.

Desired Qualifications

- Degree in Accounting, Finance, Business Administration, or related field.
- Experience using Abila MIP Fund Accounting program, or similar financial tracking system.
- Experience working with collective bargaining.
- Understanding of the dynamics of domestic violence.
