Position Overview: Every month our food order is delivered from Second Harvest Food Bank. This food order is most of the food the Shelter will need for an entire month. We provide all the meals for guests when they stay at the shelter – and as a Food Delivery volunteer you would be helping with that.

Key Responsibilities: There is a lot of physical activity with this position. You will be lifting and carrying heavy packages into the Shelter. Unpacking food and breaking down cardboard boxes.

Impact of the assignment: Without you, we wouldn't be able to feed the adults and children that we serve. Food plays a vital role when it comes to healing and because of your help, we are able to meet that basic need.

Time commitment: 1-4pm on the last Thursday of the month.

Qualifications:

- The ability to lift and carry heavy packages.
- Attention to detail.

- Will need to complete a basic level background check.
