As one of only two domestic violence shelters north of the Twin Cities, Safe Haven serves a seven county region of northeastern Minnesota, and the demand for our services has increased over the past several years. We just remodeled and expanded our crisis shelter to increase capacity from 39 to 55 beds. Your sponsorship has real impact on the lives of survivors and their families, as the funds raised at our annual luncheon allow us to continue our comprehensive programming from crisis to a life free from violence.

OUR MISSION IS PROVIDING:

SAFETY

Safe Haven staffs a 24/7 crisis hotline and shelter providing safe, temporary housing for over 500 adults and children fleeing domestic violence annually. We provide food, clothing, transportation, shelter and other basic needs in a secure and confidential shelter with 55 beds.

SPACE TO HEAL

Once survivors and their families are stabilized comes the hard work of beginning to heal. Shelter staff provide one-on-one support to each individual we serve, creating a safe and supportive environment where survivors can address both their physical and emotional traumas. Support groups help survivors to know they are not alone.

ADVOCACY

Safe Haven's drop-in Resource Center assists over 1,500 survivors every year. Our Legal Advocacy Program assists with Orders for Protection, Harassment Restraining Orders, and accompanies victims to court. We support the voice of survivors in the criminal justice system.

EMPOWERMENT

The Resource Center also houses our Self-Sufficiency and Youth Programs, which help empower survivors to create a life free from violence. These programs assist with obtaining a GED and/or higher education, finding a job, and locating stable housing. Youth are empowered to self-advocate as they learn to recognize and manage the trauma created by domestic violence, what healthy relationships look like, and early signs of abuse.
